### BOWLER OF THE YEAR AWARDS

PURPOSE: To select the youth and adult, female and male bowler of the year. To determine the Bowler Of the Year the following criteria is to be submitted by the bowler

1. Finishing first, second or third in any event or division of any local London & District Tenpin Association C.T.F. 2. Finishing in the top ten averages in this Association for the season in league play. For the purpose of the category, the averages shall be the composite of 2 or more leagues. The bowler must have bowled a minimum of 60 games in each league as submitted for the Year Book. If in a short season league 48 games must be bowled. 8. Bowling a three game series of 550 - 599 <b>(women &amp; youth only)</b>		2 points for each one (in different centre) and 1 point for each additional one in the same centre
9. Bowling a single game of 300		12 points for each one (in different centre) and 3 points for each additional one in the same centre
10 Bowling a single game of 299		8 points for each one (in different centre) and 2 points for each additional one in the same centre

11. Bowling a single game of 298	6 points for each one (in different centre) and 1 point for each additional one in the same centre		
12. Bowling a game with 11 strikes in a row and Scoring 297 or less	4 points for each one (in different centre) and 1 point for each additional one in the same centre		
13. Bowling a single game of 275 – 289	4 points for each one (in different centre) and 1 point for each additional one in the same centre		
14. Bowling a single game of 250 – 274 <b>(women &amp; youth only)</b>	3 points for each one (in different centre) and 1 point for each additional one in the same centre		
15. Bowling a single game of 225 – 249 <b>(youth only)</b>	2 points for each one (in different centre) and 1 point for each additional one in the same centre		
16. Finishing first, second, or third in any event of a F.I.Q. 20. Finishing first, second, or third in Zone and House rounds for advancement to Provincial and or National when house round is played with separate CTF sanction such as World Cup and YBTs	POINTS 1 <sup>st</sup> – 5 points 2 <sup>nd</sup> – 3 points 3 <sup>rd</sup> – 1 point		

RULES:

1. The year for point accumulation shall be from June 1<sup>st</sup> to May 31<sup>st</sup>. Any tournament results not available by May 31<sup>st</sup> will be held for consideration the following season.
2. All information regarding tournament results, averages, high series or game award application must be on file at the Association Office in order that a member can be credited with the correct point total for any achievements.
3. All members of the London & District Tenpin Bowling Association, in good standing are eligible to win this award.
4. Achievements 1 through 15, league and local tournaments scores must be bowled under the jurisdiction of the London & District Tenpin Bowling Association (included are London members of current/future CTF sanctioned Travel Leagues when a session is bowled in our jurisdiction). Individual bowl off scores are not recognized.
5. The responsibility for reporting any position that accumulates points is that of the member for any tournament other than this Association's tournaments. Results showing position along with the tournament sanction number is required. A photocopy would be accepted
6. This report shall be printed each year in the Year Book, so that all members shall know the rules and that all members shall know their responsibility of reporting their tournament scores to the Association office.
7. The Committee shall be responsible, annually, for performing all the necessary assembling of point totals and tabulating the results, so that the winners can be printed in the Year Book.
8. These awards shall be awarded annually, irrespective of the point totals accumulated in any given year.
9. This criteria is subject to review prior to June 1<sup>st</sup>.
