Open Youth Bowling Tournament

SQUADS begin at 9:30a.m. (Registration begins at 9:00am)

1. This tournament is for sanctioned youth bowlers in Ontario Youth programs. All CTF tournament rules and regulations shall govern this CTF sanctioned tournament. **All bowlers must have bowled 2/3 of the CTF youth league schedule by March 19, 2023**, before entering this tournament.
2. This tournament will be held in six divisions and will consist of three games bowled on one pair of lanes.
 - “A” AVERAGE 171 & OVER
 - “B” AVERAGE 151 to 170
 - “C” AVERAGE 135 to 150
 - “D” AVERAGE 120 to 134
 - “E” AVERAGE 101 to 119
 - “F” AVERAGE 100 and under
3. Bowlers may enter this tournament only once.
4. This tournament is a handicapped event based on 100% of the bowler’s average and 220. **The sanctioned average will be based on last year’s HIGHEST yearbook average in any association or sanctioned league whether it be a youth or adult league. If there is no previous year average, the bowlers must use a current highest average in a youth or adult league based on a minimum of 21 games as of March 19, 2023.** If the bowler does not have an eligible previous or eligible current year average, the bowler will be given a 220-scratch average.
5. The league secretary/coach will be responsible for average verifications and must sign the entry form. **The sanctioned league average sheets as of March 21 must accompany the entry forms along with a cheque to obtain a confirmation of entry in the tournament.**
6. **ENTRY CLOSING DATE WILL BE MIDNIGHT, April 3, 2023.** Only entries postmarked the first post office business day following the entry closing date shall be accepted. Each bowling center will be notified of acceptance and bowling time for each of their entries. The entry forms must contain both the names and averages of the bowlers. **Bowling fees must accompany entry forms.**
7. **No eating or alcoholic beverages allowed** at any time while participating in the tournament. Bowlers not adhering to this rule will be disqualified. Bowlers must remain in the bowling area and be ready to bowl.
8. **Dress code:** youth house bowling shirt, no hats or headgear, no electronic devices i.e., cell phones, iPod no pants with holes, tears, rips, patches, or obscenities. Skirts or shorts are allowed but no shorter than 5 cm above the knee. All coaches must abide by all tournament rules. All bowlers must supply their own bowling balls and shoes.
9. Coaches will be allowed if they are registered with the Tournament Director. Each house is allowed 1 for every ten bowlers entered in the tournament. **No on-lane coaching is allowed. Parents are not allowed on the lanes.**
10. Substitutes are allowed when replacements are necessary. The tournament director should be notified at least one hour before the scheduled bowling times, if possible.
11. Coaches must register bowlers 30 minutes prior to bowling time with sanction cards. Any bowler arriving late shall begin play with the score to count from the frame then being bowled.
12. Protests MUST be submitted in writing to the Tournament Director within 72 hours of the completion of the tournament.
13. Award fees will be returned 100% to the participants in the form of scholarships in each division.
14. Any COVID protocols mandated by the Ontario government or London Middlesex Health Unit at the time of the tournament will be required to be followed.
15. Squad times (days) will be assigned by the tournament director based on date requested and time of entry. Up to 96 bowlers can bowl in each squad time (day).
